

## Health and Social Care Cambridge Technical Year 13

Aims and Rationale: Students have already completed 50% of the qualification when they start year 13. The year 13 teaching is split across two expert teachers who each cover their own units of work. Teaching is varied and empowers students to become skilled independent learners. Students are tested regularly and rigorously and they know from the outset of the course exactly when tests will take place and when coursework deadlines need to be met. There is ample time and opportunity for feedback, reflection and improvement.
