



Year 13 Fashion & Textiles A level Yearly Plan



Term	Areas to be Covered
AUTUMN TERM 1	Final NEA: Section A (20 marks), Section B (10 marks), Section C (25 marks), Section D (25 marks), Section E (20 marks) Students will be refining their main design ideas, evaluating them against their developed design specification and gaining user feedback. They are completing initial toiles for a prototype to test construction, form and fit. They must test this on the user and get feedback making improvements and iterations to the design. Sampling a wide range of possible construction and decorative techniques will also be taking place during this half term.
	Subject Knowledge and Understanding: Once a week students focus on the exam part of the course and cover theory linked to paper two. In this half term the following units from Y12 will be recapped and applied to practise exam questions. Units 1.1 & 1.2 - sources, formation of fibres, properties, yarns, fabric construction, blending and mixing fibres. 1.3 joining materials, 1.4 finishes, 1.5 enhancement of materials.

AUTUMN TERM 2	Final NEA: Section C (25 marks), Section D (25 marks) Students are starting to create their final prototype (final product). Students complete fabric specifications, a photographic and written diary of manufacture.

SPRING TERM 1	Final NEA: Section C (25 marks), Section D (25 marks) Students are continuing to create their final prototype (final product). Students are continuing with their photographic and written diary of manufacture, in addition to detailed risk assessments and manufacturing specifications. Final prototypes must be complete by the end of this half term.
	Subject Knowledge and Understanding: In this half term the following units are explored; 2.6 selecting appropriate tools, processes & equipment, 2.7 accuracy in design & manufacture.

SPRING TERM 2	<p>Final NEA: Section E (20 marks) Students will be completing the evaluation part of their NEA / Project ensuring that they have used SWOT analysis as well as testing it against their specification. They must ensure they have fully tested their product with a user and got feedback from target customers. They also need to suggest modifications and suitability for manufacture in industry.</p>
	<p>Subject Knowledge and Understanding: In this half term the following units are explored; 2.8 responsible design, 2.9 design for manufacture, 2.10 national & international standards in design.</p>

	<p>Exam Preparation: Students complete independent personalised revision plans for their Fashion & Textiles exam. They complete past papers and self mark using markschemes. They create their own revision materials using methods that work best for them. There are a wealth of practice questions available to practise with from each individual unit so that students can focus their revision to specific units which they know they need to revise.</p>
