  - 1 child living in the parish of Hemel Hempstead previously allocated their 3<sup>rd</sup> preference school Laureate Academy was allocated their 2<sup>nd</sup> preference The Adeyfield Academy. This reduced the total number allocated to Laureate Academy from 216 to 215.
- 2 children living in Buckinghamshire were withdrawn from Tring School (EHCP), and in turn:
  - 1 child living in the parish of Tring Rural previously allocated an ontime Non Ranked Allocation to Laureate Academy was allocated their first preference Tring School, taking the number of Non Ranked Allocation at Laureate from 109 to 108. Reducing the total allocated at Laureate Academy from 215 to 214.
- 1 child living in Harpenden was withdrawn from Roundwood Park Secondary School (EHCP), and in turn:
  - 1 child living in Markyate previously allocated an ontime Non Ranked Allocation to Laureate Academy was allocated their first preference Roundwood Park Secondary School. This reduced the total number of Non Ranked Allocations to Laureate Academy from 108 to 107, reducing the total allocated at Laureate Academy from 214 to 213.
- 1 child living in Hemel Hempstead was withdrawn from Longdean School, and in turn:
  - 1 child living in Hemel Hempstead previously allocated an ontime Non Ranked Allocation to Laureate Academy was allocated their fourth preference Longdean School. This reduced the total number of Non Ranked Allocations to Laureate Academy from 107 to 106, reducing the total allocated at Laureate Academy from 213 to 212.
