



Equipment list needed for starting HGS in September

All students Years 7 - 11:

Essential:

- Chromebook in a protective sleeve (details to follow about purchasing through school scheme)
- Water bottle (ideally clear)
- Pencil case (any)
- The normal pencil case contents; i.e. black/blue pens, green and purple biro (needed in lots of subjects), pencils, ruler, rubber, pencil sharpener (preferably one that collects the sharpenings), highlighters
- Scissors
- Pritt stick type glue
- Colouring pencils and pens
- Small set of artists pencils ie 4B, 2B, B, HB, H for use in Art and Technology
- Set of headphones 3.5mm jack (used regularly in Computing/Music/Art and Design/Design and Technology lessons as well as other subject lessons)
- A plastic A4 folder/wallet to store loose sheets
- Maths Calculator - 83GT CW (battery powered) or 85GT CW (solar powered) model *which are generally between £16.50 - £18.50*
- Any geometry set - the Oxford set is good, but do try and get one with a metal rather than a plastic compass. Must include Protractor, Ruler, Pair of compasses.
- Apron for Art - this can be an apron, old shirt/tshirt so long as it covers their uniform.

Optional:

- Paperclips and/or small bulldog type clips for organising/storing loose sheets in books.
- Coloured post it notes/cards for summarising notes/revision at the end of each project/unit.
- Mini Dictionary
- Mini Thesaurus
- Mini French / Spanish dictionary

All items must be labelled with student name.
