A Level Literature Club	We will explore academic writing skills, enhance understanding of critical interpretations, and develop language analysis.
Art Club	A chance to get creative at lunchtime and create some fun and exciting artworks.
Biology Club	A year 7 club for all things Biology and related Sciences.
Brass Group	Pupils learning brass (including saxes) are welcome to join this exciting ensemble.

Clarinet Choir	For pupils who are learning Clarinet, a useful opportunity to play with others and develop music and social skills.

We alternate between writer's craft and writer's workshop to allow opportunities to explore writing strategies and techniques, and share their work.
