- Identify any job roles or opportunities that you may want to research further after the Futures Fair.

- Smile and be friendly.

- Move quickly, quietly around the exhibition, if there are already people talking to the exhibitor you want to speak to, look to see if there is a visitor without someone talking with them and head their way first!
- At the end of your session, take the time to **thank the person** who has been talking to you. *This will be appreciated*.

Questions

These are some useful questions you can use when speaking to our visitors.

Industries & Employers

- What was the route into your current job?
- What does a typical day look like for you?
- Do you have to work in shift patterns or unsocial hours or weekends?
- Is there any useful work experience you think would be helpful to get into your sector?
- What impact do you think AI will have on your industry?
- What is the biggest challenge you have ever faced in your work?
- Why did you enter this line of work?
- Looking back -What do you wish you'd known at my age?
- What would you like to do next career wise?
- What changes has your organisation made to be more sustainable?
- How does your company reduce its environmental impact?

FE Colleges and Universities

- What grades do I need for my chosen course?
- If I was choosing A levels is there anything you would suggest?
- How is the work generally assessed?
- How many students are there on the course I have chosen?
- How many contact (taught) hours are there each week?
- What careers provision do you have?
- What are the progression routes and options after the course?
- What is your job role at the university/college?
- What is a typical day like for you?
- What do you think you will do next for a career move?
