



Time to discuss:

What does the word refuge

mean to you?





The theme of this year's **National Poetry Day** is **Refuge.**

Every year there is a different theme.

One definition of refuge is:



the state of being safe or sheltered from pursuit, danger or difficulty.

Refuge may mean different things to different people: it may be a person, a place or an object which makes someone feel safe.

What about the poem makes you feel this way and why?


How does it fit with the theme of refuge?

or


a piece of artwork

When you have created your entry, upload it onto our specially created Google Classroom. Here's the code: **hdiu4rb**






Deadline: straight after half term (30th October 2023)

You will notice lots of eye-catching imagery on the website too.


If you have spare time in form:
