- Basic need provision (food, toiletries, household items).

- Regular SADA Drop-In sessions available virtually.
- You Me and Mum course, to help parents to support their children.
- Domestic abuse training to partner agencies.

SADA works collaboratively with partner agencies to provide support to victims, survivors and those closest to them.
