Year 10 English Literature Shakespeare Set Text

After the Christmas break, we will be studying our set Shakespeare text in English. Your child will be studying **Romeo and Juliet**. It is important that students are able to make notes and annotate the text for their GCSE studies and later revision and so we ask that students purchase their own copies of the texts to keep. Any edition of the play is suitable and there is no expectation that all students have the same copy. Pre-used editions (for example, those used by siblings in previous years) are also suitable.
