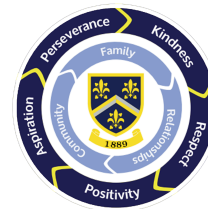

Dear Parent / Guardian,

Re: Sixth Form Induction 2026 and Sixth Form Uniform Protocols

I would like to take this opportunity to inform parents, guardians and students of the following information.

Please be advised that all students intending to join the Sixth Form at Hitchin Girls' School in September 2026 are expected to attend a three day taster event on **Monday 22 June, Tuesday 23 June and Wednesday 24 June 2026**. All three Sixth Forms (Hitchin Girls' School, Hitchin Boys' School and The Priory School) are working together to run this collaborative taster programme.

During these three days, students will have the opportunity to:

- Experience subjects they are considering studying through taster lessons
- Meet new students, both external to Hitchin Girls' School and across the consortium
- Meet the Sixth Form team at Hitchin Girls' School;
- Bridging homework tasks, which will be set for the Summer holidays and handed in during the first lesson in September
- Receive important Sixth Form information, including expectations and standards

Please note that these are taster days only. The subject blocks have not yet been confirmed. Students will receive their Individual timetables during the week before the induction. The timetable will show the lessons, times, and locations that students need to attend.

Students should bring a copy of their timetable with them each day.

Dress Code for Induction

During induction, students are asked to wear **smart business attire**. A suit is not required for these days.

Sixth Form Uniform (from September)

Students who are successful in attaining a place in the Sixth Form will be required to wear the following in:

- A skirt, dress or trouser suit.
- A jacket/blazer (this is a compulsory part of the uniform)
- Stretch tube skirts are not acceptable
- Shirts or top may be any colour, but must not have logos
- Shoes or boots may be worn, the following are not permitted, Ugg-style boots, Plimsolls or Trainers will be accepted.

Sixth Form Entry Criteria

Can I please also take this opportunity to remind all students that the Standard entry requirement to our Consortium is:

- Five GCSEs at Grade 9-4 (or equivalent)
- Including English and Maths at Grade 4 or above
- A minimum overall GCSE Average Points Score (APS) of 4.
